Dear Karol and Pie,

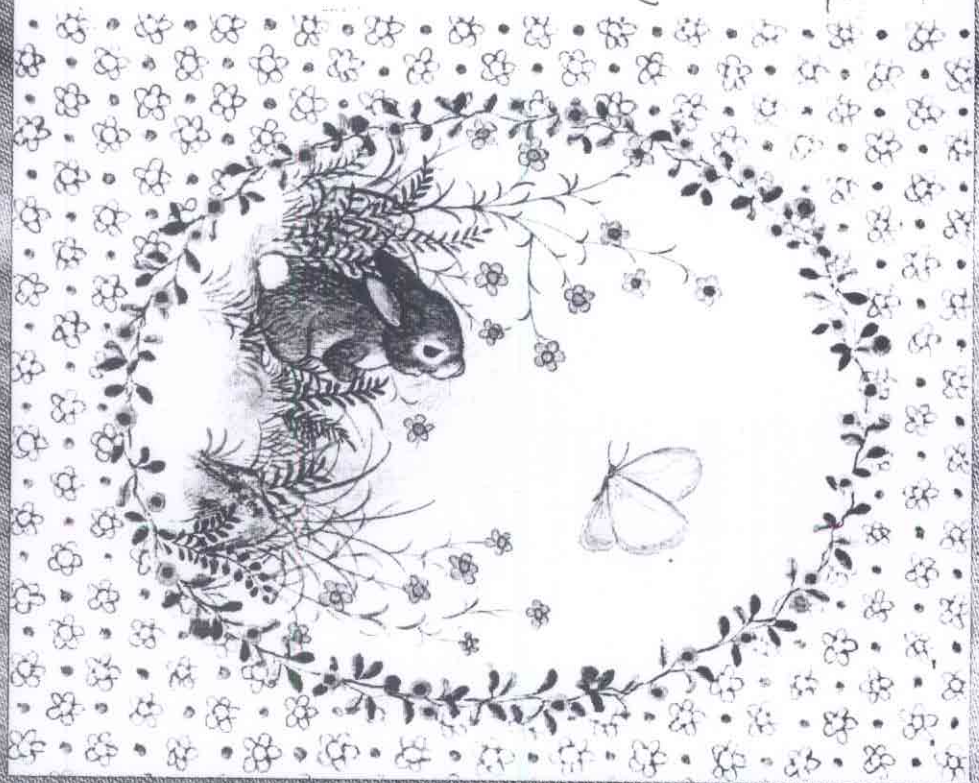
