Dear Mr. Wollin,

I'd like to be able to accept your invitation to the Red Friday Party but I cannot. I'd like to be able to make a financial contribution, but the writing I've been doing has been impoverishing. There is only one way in which I might be able to help, and that I offer.

Mine was the first writing on the Warren Report. My first book is the one that opened the field. It had to be an unusual private printing, by offset reproduction of the retyped manuscript. Since then I have been no more welcome to publishers. Three of my four published books, each of which brought to light information until then unpublished, had to be private printings of this sort. With the fourth, I was co-publisher. It, however, is in the usual form. Each of these three contains photo reproductions of the suppressed evidence of the John Kennedy assassination. The last of the series has 150 pages of this.

So, my books are sort of collectors items, aside from their content. If you can use them to raise money, I'll send you as a contribution to peace whatever you like. I'm leaving on an investigative trip to New Orleans in the morning, so they can not reach your party in time, but if you can sell them separately, either I'll ship them on my return or my wife will in advance of it.

May I add these books are really on the essence of the peace issue? John Kennedy had changed national policy. His murder ended the changes he had announced and begun. Thus the issue of his murder and more, its fake official investigation, is really the crux of the peace issue, as my unpublished work will show.

Sorry I cannot be of more immediate help.
