With the fourth, I was co-publisher. It, however, is in the usual form. Each of these three contains photo reproductions of the suppressed dvidence of the John Kannedy assessination. The last of the series has 150 pages of this.

I'm leaving on an investigative trip to New Orleans in the morning, so they can of reach your party in time, but if you can call them separately, either I'll ship them on my return or my wife will in advance of it.

Thus the issue of his murder and more, its fake official investigation, is really the crux of the peace issue, as my unpublished work will show.
