2 Groups Ask Hill to Deny SACB Funds

Associated Press Americans for Democratic Action and the American Civil Liberties Union have asked Congress to deny funds to continue the Subversive Activities Control Board.

The board is a "leftover bureaucracy from a happily bygone era," they said, and its \$706,000 budget is a waste of taxpayers' money.

They said the board's new assignment from President Nixon to update the attorney general's list of subversive organizations is part of an unconstitutional evaluation of federal employee loyalty.
