Twenty-five groups on the Attorney General's subversive list don't exist any more, the 4 Subversive Activities Control Board said yesterday. And one 4 of them hasn't been around for 32 years. 4

The board announcement was the latest in a weedingout process. Only the Attorney General has authority to remove an organization from the list.
