DATE A CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT OF HIS, WHO DOES NOT DESIRED TO BE INTERVIEWED, STATED HE WAS AT THE TOWN AND COUNTRY RESTAURANT, NEW ORLEANS, LA., IN MARCH OR APRIL, SIXTYTHREE, WHEN HE OBSERVED AN UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL WHO LOOKED LIKE PICTURES OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD INFORMANT OBSERVED ON TV AND IN NEWSPAPERS. THIS UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL WAS WEARING A DARK SUIT AND WAS ACCOMPANIED BY A BLOND HEADED WOMAN. THE INFORMANT OBSERVED THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVE A LARGE SUM OF MONEY FROM THE OWNER OF TOWN AND COUNTRY RESTAURANT. OWNER IS DESCRIBED AS INDIVIDUAL OF ITALIAN DESCENT. INFORMANT BELIEVES OWNER HAS BUSINESS INTERESTS IN DALLAS AND FORT WORTH, TEXAS. HARRIS CONTACTING HIS INFORMANT REQUESTING THAT HE MAKE HIMSELF AVAILABLE FOR INTERVIEW BY BUAGENTS.

NEW ORLEANS, WILL DETERMINE IF OWNER OF TOWN AND COUNTRY RESTAURANT CONTACT OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AND IF DEEMED APPROPRIATE, CONTACT OWNER TO DETERMINE RELATIONSHIP.

ANTHONY MARCELLO, MANAGER, TOWN AND COUNTRY MOTEL, ADJACENT TO THE TOWN AND COUNTRY RESTAURANT, STATES HE HAS NEVER SEEN ANYONE RESEMBLING LEE OSWALD STAYING AT THE TOWN AND COUNTRY MOTEL. HE SAID JACK RUBY WAS UNKNOWN TO HIM.

For information Dallas and Savannah, the Town and Country Motel and Restaurant, 1225 Airline Highway, New Orleans, is owned and operated by such individuals JOSEPH ALBERT PORETTO, who actively manages the restaurant, subject of NC file 92-47 and by JOSEPH MARCELLO, New Orleans file 92-328. JOSEPH MARCELLO is a brother of CARLOS MARCELLO and all three are known hoodlums of the New Orleans Division. CARLOS MARCELLO allegedly has had financial interest in the Town and Country Motel and Restaurant in years past. The Town and Country Motel and Restaurant is a known hangout for the hoodlum element.

JOSEPH ALBERT PORETTO, owner, Town and Country Restaurant, 1225 Airline Highway, on interview was advised of the interviewing Agent's identity, that he was not required to submit to interview, that anything he might say could be used against him in a court of law and that he could first consult an attorney. No threats, rewards, promises or other inducements were made to PORETTO in connection with this interview and he voluntarily advised as follows:

On examination of a photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD New Orleans Police Department number 112723, Mr. PORETTO said he had never seen this individual in person before and was positive that he had never had any business dealings or association of any kind with this person.

According to Mr. PORETTO, since the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, he had seen numerous photos and TV shots of both LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK LEON RUBY since that time and had never seen or known of either person prior to this time. He said he had never heard of JACK RUBY even by reputation prior to his notariety in the newspapers.

Mr. PORETTO stated he cannot recall having had any business dealings with anyone in about March or April, 1963 or at any other time, who resembled OSWALD enough for a mistaken identity.

HE DESCRIBED OWNER OF RESTAURANT AS WHITE MALE, AGE FIFTY, SIX FEET TALL, TWO HUNDRED FIFTY POUNDS, DARK COMPLEXION, GRAY HAIR, COMBED STRAIGHT BACK.

NEW ORLEANS WIL CONDUCT APPROPRIATE INVESTIGATION TO ASCERTAIN IF INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN ABOVE INDICENT MIGHT BE OSWALD.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Lt. JOHNNIE HARRIS, Glynn County Police Department, Brunswick, Ga., advised SA QUENTIN M. VAUGHAN on 11/26/63 that his confidential informant did not desire to be interviewed. It was explained to Lt. HARRIS the absolute necessity of his confidential informant to be interviewed by Bureau Agents and HARRIS stated he would contact his confidential informant, requesting that he make himself available for interview by Bureau Agents.

Lt. HARRIS advised on 11/27/63 that his confidential informant was out of town on business and he could not contact him until 11/29/63.

Lt. HARRIS was contacted on 11/29/63, at which time he advised he had contacted his confidential informant who agreed to be interviewed. HARRIS' confidential informant was interviewed on this same date by SA JOHN P. McWIFE.

Information received from Lt. HARRIS on 11/26/63 and interview with HARRIS' confidential informant on 11/29/63 was furnished to the Bureau and Dallas and New Orleans Offices by teletypes dated 11/26/63 and 11/29/63 in case captioned "JACK LEON RUBY, aka; LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka - VICTIM, Deceased, CR", office of origin Dallas, Savannah file 44-1200.

Attempts were made on 11/30/63 and 12/1/63 to contact SA T-1 to display photograph of OSWALD, however, he was out of town and was due back on 12/2/63 or 12/3/63.

Synopsis:

Sgt. JOHNNY HARRIS, Glynn County Police Department, Brunswick, Ga., advised 11/26/63 he received information that date from SV T-1 who stated he was at Town and Country Restaurant, New Orleans, La., in March or April, 1963, and observed individual who looked like pictures of LEE HARVEY OSWALD he had observed on television and in the newspapers in connection with the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. SV T-1 interviewed on 11/29/63 and stated sometime between 2/15/63 and 3/15/63 he was at Town and Country Restaurant, New Orleans, La., and observed individual believed to be OSWALD receive "wad of money" under the table from restaurant owner. Attempt was made on 11/30/63 and 12/1/63 to display OSWALD's photograph to SV T-1 but he was unavailable.

DETAILS:

AT BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA:

Lieutenant JOHNNY HARRIS, Glynn County Police Department, advised on November 26, 1963, that he received information from SV T-1 on that date who stated he was at the Town and Country Restaurant at New Orleans, Louisiana, in March or April, 1963, and observed an individual who looked like pictures of LEE HARVEY OSWALD that SV T-1 had observed recently on television and in newspapers in connection with the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. HARRIS stated SV T-1 told him this individual was wearing a dark suit and was accompanied by a blonde-headed woman. SV T-1 observed this individual receive a large quantity of money from the owner of this restaurant whom SV T-1 described as being of Italian descent.

SV T-1 was interviewed on November 29, 1963. He stated that between February 15, 1963, and April 15, 1963, he made a business trip to Texas and stopped at New Orleans, Louisiana, where he made some business calls and traveled back to Georgia. One night he and a friend were introduced to the owner of the Town and Country Restaurant in New Orleans. He was unable to recall the restaurant owner's name but he described him as a white male, age 50, 6 feet tall, 250 pounds, dark complexion, gray hair, combed straight back and of Italian ancestry. SV T-1 stated he and his friend went into the main dining room of the restaurant where there were customers only at two other tables. SV T-1 observed a young couple enter the dining room and sit at a table about two tables from where he and his companion were sitting. SV T-1 stated this man greatly resembled photographs of LEE HARVEY OSWALD whom he had seen during the past week on television and in the newspapers in connection with the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

The restaurant owner joined this couple at their table and SV T-1 observed the restaurant owner remove a "wad of money" from his pocket which he passed under the table to the man sitting at the table. A few minutes later the couple left the restaurant.

SV T-1 stated this was the only occasion he met the restaurant owner and he knows nothing of his background, associates, racial or extremist views or activities.

He stated further this was the only occasion that he observed the individual he believes might be identical with OSWALD. He stated the individual he observed at the restaurant who might be identical with OSWALD was dressed in a dark suit and dark tie. His woman companion was a white female, age 22-26 years of age, blond hair and a flashy dresser.

AT DARIEN, GEORGIA:

- SV T-1 was re-interviewed on 12/2/63 and a full length front view and profile view photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, New Orleans, Louisiana, Police Department Number 112723, taken on August 9, 1963, was displayed to him.

SV T-1 advised this photograph resembles the individual he observed one night at the Town and Country Restaurant in New Orleans between February 15, 1963, and March 15, 1963.

SV T-1 made the observation that in the front view photograph of OSWALD he appeared to have a heavy beard or a start of a mustache on his upper lip, whereas the individual he observed at the Town and Country Restaurant was clean shaven.
