Dear Dr. Grover:

The Federal Bureau of Investigation has completed its survey of the documents relating to the Warren Commission files which were described in the list that was presented to this department by your agency, and has prepared five self-explanatory lists concerning those documents which the Attorney General has asked me to forward to you.

The first list describes the documents that may be publicly disclosed; the second list describes those that may be disclosed in part; the third list describes those that should not be released at this time; the fourth list describes those that are missing from your files or which were processed by other agencies; and the fifth list describes transmittal letters which were not in your files. Necessarily, the documents described in the last two lists have not been evaluated.

The Bureau notes that the documents identified as Commission Documents Numbers 294b-d, 294b-e, 294d, 294f, 294j, 294k, and 1114 were not presented to it for review at the National Archives since those documents were filed with the Warren Commission by the Department of State. Accordingly, the Bureau has not taken into consideration the effect the guidelines may have on material of the Bureau which may be included in those documents.

Furthermore, the Bureau notes that it found several instances in which documents in the possession of your

agency have been marked to indicate that they have been
declassified when such is not the case. In those instances,
the documents have been identified in the third list.
