

JDW*Really note for files Rip-Off, more on EW 6/20/74

It is almost certain the theft of these files could not have been before the night of 5/9/74. Oliver Gille, London Sunday Times, was here that afternoon, evening, over night and until about supertime on the 10th, when he left to catch his plane for England. I read from the missing documents, making a single tape he took back with him to offer to his editor as a reflection of what I have. The only overnight guest since him has been the Kabaks. This also was after the students were here, except for one who has done some work on other files for me and she was never here alone. Nobody really has been. Lew Chester was here but left about midnight, not remaining overnight. (5/24). The package would have been too large to remove with me here except in a suitcase or attache case. It was a manila legal-sized envelope and an overlarge one.
