Two days ago I returned home from six days at the Johns Hopkins hospital in Baltimore. This afternoon Clay Ogilvie returned from a trip to the basement where most of my records are with the box of Polaroid 600 film that someone had emptied there and had left behind. Clay has been working in those files when he could be near here, which had last been only about two weeks ago, and did not see this Polaroid box until hust now. Jerry McKnight also has been there and reported no empty film boxes.

Some of the boxes atop the file cabinets in my office have been moved as have several large looseleaf notebooks.

By this I do mean to suggest that there may have been other entries while I was hospitalized or in the nursing home.
