bviously, we could not have done this. Assuring it was done only the bank could have done it.

Idl's first question was how could all of this have happened in an account that did not yet exist?

Oh? Sorry, their mistake. Our other account.

Well, how come the same check (different sums on their notice) was wat

Somehow, their mistake.

When did they discover it? In September.

Deposited in May, error not discovered until September?

I do not think this is normal, nor can I think of any good reason why anyone should have been pawing through my account in September. What you and I were then doing provides reasons, but not "good" ones.

What we were doing is the Ray case and WW IV.

Ineffecient as everyone is today there may be more innocent explanations, but that we did not get any that makes sense does not encourage me to assume innocence is the only possible explanation.
