

Lennie Mudkins on Herman Kinssey; Robert Mahau; Allan Sweatt; Oswald in Mexico BW 6/24/75

After Hugh McDonald blurted out that the character Sherman Lindsay in his book is really Herman Kinssey, I phoned "annie" to ask if he recalled Kinssey. The name sounded familiar to him.
