I'm a member of Access. Allen and Walsh are friends of mine.

Re Aldredge shot and what is in the case record in D.A. 75-226, I can't remember where to search and it is now beyond me to review the entire case to find out.

I'll ask my lawyer if he can remember the dates. If he does, I can then locate that or those affidavit(s). But he is too busy to respond now and then will be away a couple of weeks. I won't even ask him until after he returns.

However, locating the underlying records is no big deal because I have them in a separate subject file.

They may not be all I got on Aldredge but they are all I made separate copies of for subject filing.

As I read the records that were disclosed by the two field offices, and they are my sources as I now recall it, I clipped pieces of paper to pages of which I wanted copies for separate subject filing. Then my wife xeroxed them. We kept and keep the disclosed records exactly as we receive them. The subject-file is made up of copies of what for me are the originals.

You should know that Aldredge had some nutty ideas, expressed them and thus helped the FBI discount what he said that was not at all nutty.

He actually suspected that they were in cahoots with the USSR and said it, according to their records.
