Thank you for your recent correspondence with respect to reopening the investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy.

The Senate Select Committee to Study Governmental Operations with respect to Intelligence Activities is currently compiling and categorizing allegations that the Warren Commission either overlooked or ignored evidence. When this initial investigation is completed, the Committee members will determine whether or not there is sufficient reason to continue this investigation and focus on specific charges.

It is my belief that unless the Committee uncovers evidence that is not presently known, it seems doubtful that any further inquiry into this matter would discover any new facts or refute the conclusions to which the Commission came.
