> TAGUE told DOLAN he was not convinced the Warren Commission had done a proper job in investigating captioned matter and began to ask DOLAN many questions.

DOLAN stated he is not interested in talking with TAGUE or anyonexim else concerning captioned matter, that he feels the Warren Commission did a thorough and complete job.

TAGHE advised DOLAN he obtained his name from the National Archieves.

-DOLAN said he had spoken with noone about what he saw and heard concerning captioned matter except the FBI. He requested that he be advised if the infram information he furnished the FBI had been made public.
