Thomas Albert Tarrants III of Mobile, Ala., and Joe Daniel Hawkins of Jackson, Miss., were charged by a Lauderdale County grand jury with placing a dyna-mite bomb at the home of

Meyer Davidson last June

30. Tarranis also was charged tempted murder of a Meri-dian policeman and a sailor stationed at the Naval Auxiliary Air Station here.
