Bombing Case

MERIDIAN, Miss. — A self-proclaimed anti-Semitic guerilla and a Ku Klux Klansman were indicted in connection with an abortive attempt to bomb a Jewish leader's home.

Thomas Albert Tarrants III of Mobile, Ala., and Joe Daniel Hawkins of Jackson, Miss., were charged by a Lauderdale County grand jury with placing a dynamite bomb at the home of

Meyer Davidson last June 30.

Tarrants also was charged with three counts of attempted murder of a Meridian policeman and a sailor stationed at the Naval Auxiliary Air Station here.
