

## Sign atop depository due removal

That familiar rent-a-car sign atop Texas School Book Depository building probably will be removed by the time the 15th anniversary of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy is marked next year.

Tuesday may mark the last anniversary the building, from which Lee Harvey Oswald allegedly shot Kennedy, is called the depository.

Dallas County will buy the building early next year. It will be converted

into a county administration building, with renovation expected to begin in June.

And one of the first steps in the remodeling will be to remove the Hertz Memorial service to mark 14th anniversary of Kennedy assassination, Page 1D.

Rent-A-Car sign that has served as a guidepost to the structure, said J. V. DeFord, assistant county public works director

Judson Shook, public works director, has told commissioners now is the time to change the name of the building. Apparently realizing the sensitive and emotional nature of changing the name, commissioners have not made a decision on Shook's recommendation.

Shook and commissioners tentatively have decided to leave vacant the sixth floor, from which the shots were fired.
