

Depository in Dallas for sale

DALLAS (AP) — The old Texas Schoolbook Depository building, an albatross around its owner's neck since the Warren Commission said President John F. Kennedy was fatally shot from one of its windows, is being publicized for sale again.

A five-by-seven-inch display advertisement appeared Friday in the Dallas Morning News and Dallas Times Herald.

It's the same ad which ran in March of 1973.

"For Sale or Lease: Famous Historic Dallas Landmark" the ad reads above a photograph of the seven-story red brick building with the familiar Hertz Rent-A-Car billboard atop it.

Below the picture, in the smallest of print, the ad notes that "It was from a window in this building, according to the Warren Commission Report, that a sniper fired the shots that killed President John F. Kennedy, and wounded Governor John Connally, on November 22, 1963."

W. H. Lewis, an agent for owner D. H. Byrd, said Friday that being a historical landmark "should help sell it."
