The WC states at R143 that "None of the Depository employees is known to have seen LHO again (after Givens allegedly saw him) until after the shooting." A footnote cites CE 1381 as the source of this information.

CE 1381 WM consists of 73 statements from TSBD employees present on the day of the assass. Part of it is a covering letter from Hoover which makes reference to Rankin's letter of March 16, 1964 and "your request that six specific items be incorporated in each statement" (22H632).

We would assume, knowing the use this was put to in the WR, that one of the six itmes would be whether anyone saw LHO before the shots and after he was (allegedly) seen by Givens. However, none of the statements contain such information, and most contain the line that the particular person did not see LHO "at the time of the shots."

Today, I obtained Mr. Rankin's letter of March 16 which lists the six items referred to by Hoover. This is from CD 706. The request is for signed statements from persosns known to have been in the TSBD on 11/22/63. The statements should reflect "the following information." Herein are listed 6 requests. The 4th reads, "If he saw LHO at that time?" The previous listings make it obvious that "at that time" refers to the time of the shots.

On June 13, 1964, Dennell C. Conlinson, Maintenance Employee, Farkland Mospital; Dallas, Temps, was chosm Embhait. Ol, a midle slug, by Special Agent Bendwall D. Coum, Faderal Bursan of Investigation. Sombinson stated it appears to be the same one he found on a hospital carmings at Farkland Mospital on Movember 22, 1963, but he cannot positively identify the bullet on Movember 22, 1963, but he cannot positively identify the bullet as the one he found and showed to Mr. O. P. Wright. At the time he found the bullet, the hospital carmings was located in the Emergency Unit on the ground floor of the hospital.

On June 12, 1964, O. P. Wright, Fersonnel Officer,
Furkland Hospital, Dalias, Texas, advised Special Agent Bardwell
D. Odum that Exhibit Cl. a rifle slug, shown to him at the time
of the imperview, looks like the slug found at Parkland Hospital
was November 22, 1968, which he gave to Richard Johnson, Special
Agent of the Secret Service. He stated he was not present at the
time the bullet was found, but on the afternoon of November 22,
1963, as he entered the Emergency Unit on the ground floor of
the hospital, Mr. Combinson, an employer, called to him and pointed
out a bullet, which was on a hospital carriage at that location.
He estimated the time as buing within an hour of the time President
Hermedy and Governor Commally were brought to the hospital. He
advised he could not positively identify Cl as being the same bullet
which was found on Hovember 22, 1963.

On June 24, 1964, Special Agent Richard E. Johnson, United States Secret Service, Washington, D. C., was shown Exhibit Cl. a risks bullet, by Special Agent Elmer Lee Toid, Federal Bureau of Investigation. Johnson advised he could not identify this bullet as the one he obtained from O. P. Wright, Parkland Hospital, Dallas, Texas, and gave to James Rowley, Chief. United States Jacrat Service, Washington, D. C., on November 22, 1963.

On June 24, 1964, James Rowley, Chief, United States Secret Service, Washington, D. C., was shown Exhibit Cl. a rifle bullet, by Special Agent Elmar Lee Tadd. Rowley advised he could

not identify this bulket as the one he received firm Special Agent Richard B. Johnson and gave to Special Agent Todd on November 22, 1965.

On June 24, 1964, Special Agent Bluer Lee Told, Washington, D. C., identified Cl. a rifle bullet, as being the sems one he received from James Rowley, Chief, United States Secret Service, Washington, D. C., on November 22, 1963. This identification was unde from initials manked thereon by Special Agent Told at the Federal Bureau of Investigation Laboratory upon receipt.
