Tampan Pledges Extradition Fight In Garrison Case

TAMPA — Free-lance writer Kerry W. Thornley, said he will fight extradition to New Orleans to face perjury charges filed by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison.

Thornley was released from the Hillsborough County Jail after a \$3,000 bond was posted. He was arrested early yesterday by a Hillsborough County deputy sheriff.

The slim, blond Thornley, who served in the U.S. Marine Corps with Lee Harvey Oswald, is charged with lying to New Orleans Grand Jury earlier this month when he testified he did not meet Oswald in New Orleans in late 1963.
