She advised that GARRETT has in the past become very violent in his political discussions concerning bresident KENNEDY, and stated that if he had the chance he would kill President KENNEDY and wished that Hitler had killed all the Jews.

Miss COBB advised that on November 20, 1963, Mr. GARRETT left Laredo, Texas, without any notice. She stated that for two or three days previous to his departure Mr. CARETT watched his mail closely.

Miss COBB stated that Mr. GARRETT's actions had appeared suspicious to her and she just wanted to report what she had observed. She stated that she had no further information.
