Grand Jury to Get Nixon Plot Case

NEW YORK — A Brooklyn grand jury will begin its investigation today of what police call a conspiracy by three Yemeni immigrants to assassinate President-elect Nixon.

Acting District Attorney Elliott Golden said his office was looking into any possibility that the case was linked to the murder of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy in Los Angeles last June.

The man accused of killing Sen. Kennedy is a native of Jordan.

There were reports that one of the three suspects traveled to Los Angeles on occasion. Golden said he knew nothing of this but "there is one aspect of that type we are looking into."

Meanwhile, in Aden, Yemen's information minister denounced the arrests and said that "Zionist-controlled officials" had "fabricated a conspiracy involving Arabs."
