Father's Bail Bond Rejected In Nixon Murder-Plot Case

NEW YORK—The Brooklyn District Attorney's office refused yesterday to approve a \$25,000 bond for Ahmed Rageh Namer, one of three Yemeni immigrants charged with conspiring to kill President-elect Nixon.

The approval was denied because the District Attorney's office wanted time to investigate the source of the bond money. This means the 43-year-old Namer must remain in jail for at least another 48 hours.

No effort was made to put up bond for Namer's sons, Hussein, 22, and Abdo, 18. They also are being held on \$25,000 bail each.
