## FAA Bars Aircraft at Nixon Site

MIAMI, Nov. 15 (AP)—Airspace near the Key Biscayne hideaway of President-elect. Richard M. Nixon has been declared off limits to aircraft at the order of the Secret Service, the Federal Aviation Administration said today.

J. M. Frazier, assistant area manager for the FAA, said planes and helicopters may not fly under 1000 feet in the restricted area without special permission from the presidential protection detail of the Se cret Service.

A request by the Associated Press to make low-level aerial pictures was turned down.

The area involved is a circle two miles across centered on Key Biscayne Elementary School near the rented home used by the Nixons.

The order, in force indefinitely, was issued under special Federal aviation regulation No. 20, Frazier said.
