lower bail for two Yemeni
immigrants charged with
conspiring to assassinate
President-elect Nixon. President-elect Nixon.

The two are Hussein Namer, 20, and his brother, Abdo, 18. Present in the courtroom was the boys'

father, Ahmed, who is free on \$25,000 bail under the same charge.

Attorney David Price asked the Court to reduce the \$25,000 bail for the brothers to \$7500. He told the Court the main witness against the Namers had threatened to "get even" with them for throwing him out of their apartment.
