2d Namer Out

NEW YORK—A \$25,000 bond as posted in State Supreme Court for 19-year-old Abdo Ahman Namer, who with his father and older brother is accused of conspiring to assassinate President-elect Nixon.

His brother, Hussein, 21, remains in jail. The father, Ahmad R. Namer, 43, was released in \$25,000 bond last Friday.

The three were arrested four days after the election in response to an informant's call to police. Attorneys for the Namers have charged the informant had threatened to "get even" with them after he was kicked out of their apartment because of his "addiction to alcohol."
