Kill-Nixon Threat

A 20-year-old youth from Hudson, N.Y., was indicted by a Federal grand jury on a charge of threatening the life of President Nixon. Michael Steven Shetsky allegedly made the threats on April 6.

In Denver, a Lowry Air Force Base airman was charged with threatening the President's life. Garry Martin, of Detroit, was arraigned before a U.S. Commissioner and then released on \$5000 bond.
