

Man Held in Calls About Agnew Plane

SPOKANE, Wash., Aug. 4 (AP)—A Spokane man was arrested Thursday on federal charges of giving false information concerning a bomb threat to the aircraft used by Vice President Spiro Agnew when he was here last week.

The criminal complaint filed by U.S. Atty. Dean C. Smith charges that Craig A. Van Wey, 22, made two phone calls in the early morning of July 26 saying that Agnew's plane would not be leaving because a bomb was on board. Agnew was in Spokane for a Republican fund-raising dinner.
