Death Threats 6-7-72

SAN FRANCISCO—A San Francisco man has been arrested after telephone calls threatening death to Sens. Hubert H. Humphrey and George McGovern were traced to his home, police said.

Edward J. Jordan, 38, was booked Thursday night for investigation of threatening a presidential candidate, a federal offense. Humphrey and McGovern are campaigning in California for the Democratic presidential nomination.

Jordan denied making the calls, police said.

Three Secret Service

agents and three San Francisco policemen broke down doors to enter Jordan's home and make the arrest, a police spokesman said. He said there was no indication the officers found any weapons.
