

Cuba Chooses New Education Minister

HAVANA, Oct. 8 (AP)—Jose Llanusa, former director of the National Institute of Sports, Physical Education and Recreation, was named Minister of Education today. He replaces Armando Hart, who now is the secretary general of the Cuban Communist Party.

Llanusa also served as head of the National Tourism Institute. Armando Rivas Patterson took over that post. Jesus Betancourt, former assistant director, was appointed to head the Sports Institute.
