'Gravely Concerned'

TOKYO — The U.S. is "gravely concerned" over the sale of tuna fish to Cuba by Japanese fishing boats operating in the Caribbean, a Foreign Ministry source said. The U.S. Embassy said it had expressed "interest" in the whole volume of Japanese trade with Cuba — including textiles, machinery and light consumer goods, but mostly the tuna aspect.
