DRTMUND — Helmut Schmidt, a Social Demorat foreign affairs expert, told the opposition party's congress yesterday that West Germany should give up and aspirations of becoming a nuclear power. He added that even participation in a NATO multilateral nuclear force would be considered an "unbearable danger" by the Soviet Union and other European states.

In another development, the Bonn government rejected a Social Democrat proposal for the establishment of a West German Council to work out a common approach for German reunification. Chief spokesman Guenter von Hase told a news conference that no political solutions could be expected from such a council. The proposal had been made previously by Social Democratic leader Willy Brandt.
