The high-flying B-52s staged three raids on Vietnam—the normal pace had been one per day. On Saturday, two B-52 missions were flown.

Two of the targets in Sunday's raids were infiltration routes and base camps 10 miles southwest of Hue. The other was a suspected Vietcong propaganda center and "Radio Liberation" station 75 miles northwest of Szigon and five miles from the Cambodian border.

An assault force of U.S. Marines of the 7th Fleet Special Landing Force swarmed ashore in an amphibious landing Saturday 25 miles south of Quinhon.

The leathernecks, an estimated 600 men, met only slight resistance. Three Viet cong were killed by air at-tacks supporting the landing, and Marines on the ground captured two others.
