

## Hill Unit Eyes Chairman of Joint Chiefs

The Senate Armed Services Committee may ask Gen. George S. Brown, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, to publicly explain his remarks on the power and influence of the "Jewish lobby" in the United States.

The committee will hold a closed meeting today to discuss the implications of the general's remarks at Duke University law school on Oct. 10.

Congressional sources said Sen. Thomas J. McIntyre (D-N.H.), who has called for Brown's resignation, will demand that the committee hold public hearings and call Brown to testify.
