

Eisenhower 1/17/61:

"In the Council of Government, he must guard against the deposition of unexamined influence, whether by the military - ~~in civilian complex~~ brought a unsought, by the military industrial complex. The potential for the disastrous use of misplaced power is not small.

We must never let the weight of this burden endanger our liberties or democratic processes...."
