Uruguay Severs Ties With Cuba

MONTEVIDEO, Sept. 8 (AP) Uruguay decided tonight to break relations with Castro Cuba. That left Mexico as the only American republic maintaining such relations.

The Uruguayan decision was reached at a meeting of the Government Council, which functions as the executive in place of a President in Uruguay.

The announcement said the break in relations was in compliance with a majority recommendation of the Organization of American States last July 26 that all American nations break with Cuba because of its export of subversion to other countries.
