

## Refueling of A-Planes Shifted to Sea Areas

MADRID, Jan. 26—The U.S. Air Force will conduct future refueling flights over the sea rather than over Spanish land, informed Spanish resources said today.

There were also reliable reports that the United States has banned all flights over Spain by planes carrying nuclear weapons.

The new rules follow the loss of a "nuclear device" in a collision of two U.S. planes over Spain Jan. 17.

The search for the missing

device in 200 fathoms of water off the Spanish Mediterranean coast continued. UPI quoted a highly reliable source as saying that the missing device is an unarmed nuclear bomb—and that a bathysphere is on its way to carry the search into the deeps. U.S. ships and frogmen have so far failed to turn up the missing bomb, but press reports said objects emitting radiation have been located by underwater detection devices.
