

## Bomb Recovery To Take Time

MURCIA, Spain, April 3—Recovery of a missing American hydrogen bomb from the Mediterranean may take two or three weeks, Ambassador Angier Biddle Duke was quoted as saying today.

"It is not an easy task, there is a fair depth and the work is done with the maximum caution," he said in an interview with the local newspaper *Linea*.

The bomb was reported yesterday to have plunged into deep mud 2500 feet under the sea when a hoisting cable broke. It fell into the sea Jan. 17 when a U.S. Air Force B-52 bomber crashed after a collision with a tanker plane.
