

H-Bomb Sighter To Be Rewarded

MADRID, June 23—A Madrid newspaper has raised about \$1200 toward a new shrimp boat for a Spanish fisherman who helped the Americans find a lost hydrogen bomb.

Francisco Simo of Agullas saw the bomb fall into the sea off southeast Spain Jan. 17 following a mid-air collision between a B-52 bomber and a refuelling tanker. U.S. officials acknowledged his help in locating the weapon which was recovered about 80 days later.

The Spanish Navy Ministry announced yesterday that Simo would be given the Navy Cross of Merit.
