

MIAMI, Fla., July 25 (AP).— Three exile groups withdrew from Manuel Ray's revolu-tionary junta today protesting that he failed to make good his promise to enter Cuba to reac-tivate the anti-Castro underground.

The seceding members will form a new activist party under Manuel Urrutia, Fidel Castro's first President, a spokesman for the group told a news confer-

ence. Mr. Urrutia lives in exile in New York.

The spokesman, Jesus Dieguez, of the Revolutionary National Assembly, said the withdrawing groups included 300 "men of action."
