

Castro Foes Set Strategy Talks

MIAMI, June 29 (AP)—The anti-Castro revolutionary junta, whose chief, Manuel Ray, was thwarted a year ago in an attempt to enter Cuba, announced today that its leaders will assemble next weekend to plan strategy.

The July 3-5 gathering in Tampa will draw between 50 and 100 officials from Venezuela, Puerto Rico, other Latin American countries and U.S. cities, said Alfredo Perez, a spokesman for the junta.
