

Cubans Reported Backing Rebels

MEXICO CITY, Feb. 26
(UPI)—Cuban refugees here reported today that the chief of Premier Fidel Castro's secret police has complained that it is impossible to stamp out antigovernment guerillas in Cuba because they have too much popular support.

A spokesman for the refugee Revolutionary Student Directorate said a report recently presented to Castro's Cabinet by state security chief Jose Abrahante was smuggled out of Cuba by "secret sources."

The student group said Abrahante reported "a highly alarming grade of demoralization in the militia and unwillingness among the peasants to collaborate by denouncing the antiregime elements hidden in various mountain ranges around the island."
