Cubans Seeking Liberation Aid

HARTFORD, Conn., Oct. 17 (UP) Seven foot-weary, fatigue-clad Cubans, who are making a march from Boston to Washington to drum up support for an "All-Cuban Liberation Force," arrived here today for a brief stopover.

The seven, led by Miguel A. Peraza of the 2056th Bay of Pigs Brigade, started their trek last Sunday. In Washington, they hope to meet personally with President Johnson.

The marchers said they are seeking American arms, supplies and moral support for a future liberation attempt. They say they are not asking and do not want American soldiers to help them liberate their homeland.
