Cubans Back 'War Board'

MIAMI (UPI) — The Cuban Revolutionary Council headed by former Premier Manuel A. de Varona announced Friday it has thrown its support to the newly-created, five-man Cuban exile "War Board" in a

new effort to topple the Fidel Castro regime. The council, in whose name the 1961 Bay of Pigs invasion was launched, dissolved itself. The War Board was organized by Eñido Ojiva, deputy commander of the 1961 invasion.

Cuban exiles, meanwhile, reported a 250-man Castro militia unit defected last April and is operating with rebel forces.
