Boat Seized After Mission

MIAMI (UPI) — Two exile groups said Tuesday night an armed motor launch seized by U. S. customs agents near Key West Tuesday was returning from an "infiltration and supply" mission to Cuba.

The Revolutionary Insurrectional Recovery Movement and Commandos also confirmed in a joint statement that a twin-engine attack bomber confiscated Sunday night near West Palm Bach also belonged to them.

Customs agents said there was a large quantity of bombs, floating mines, plastic explosives, a 20 MM cannon and grenade launcher, as well as detonators and fuses, aboard the vessel.
