**Cubans Return
2 U.S. Marines**

MIAMI, March 2 (UPI) — Two U.S. Marines arrested by Cuban authorities while fishing in Cuban water near the Guantanamo Naval Base last Sunday arrived here today aboard a Cuba refugee airlift plane.

Pfc. Vaughn David Muller, 19, of Erie, Pa., and Pfc. Richard A. Monaco, 18, of Milton, N.J., were still wearing civilian clothes when they stepped off the airlift plane, which brought in another group of refugees.

Muller and Monaco were seized by Cuban officials when their small outboard motorboat allegedly entered Cuban waters off the big U.S. naval base. They were turned over to the Swiss Embassy in Havana Monday night for transfer to the United States.
