Soviet Blames All Except Cuba

MOSCOW, Aug. 10 — The organization of American States (OAS) has "charged the republic of Cuba, arbitrarily and without any proof, of aggression and interference in the internal affairs of another state, and new hostile steps against this country are being envisaged," according to a Soviet government statement today.

The real threat to peace was constituted by the "aggressive actions" against Cuba, in which Guatemala, Nicaragua and other Latin-American states were taking direct part, the statement said, as quoted by the Soviet news agency Tass.

The statement was addressed to the U.N. Security Council in protest against the resolution adopted on July 25 by the ninth consultative conference of foreign ministers of the Organization of American States following the supposed "complaint" of Venezuela, Tass said.
