Cuba Stand Clarified by **Fulbright**

LONDON, May 5-Sen. J. William Fulbright said today that he does not favor American trade with Cuba so long as the Castro regime is exporting revolution.

The chairman of the Senate Relations Committee plained that his March Senate speech in which he noted that the American economic embargo of Cuba was ineffective had been misinterpreted abroad. Incomplete reports of what he said have been cited here as justification for the sale of British buses to Cuba.

Fulbright (D-Ark.), who is enroute to Greece and Turkey at the suggestion of President Johnson to emphasize the urgency which the United States attaches to a Cyprus solution, spent an hour conferring with Prime Minister Douglas-Home.

Declining to give details except that the conversation touched Cuba, Aden, Malaysia and NATO as well as Cyprus, Fulbright said that cated Cyprus solution.
