SISTER URGES
MILITARY TO
TOPPLE CASTRO

MIAMI(AP)--Juanita Castro Wednesday urged the Cuban armed forces to overthrow the regime of her brother Fidel.

Speaking on the 10th anniversary of Fidel Castro's takeover in Cuba, the self-exiled Miss Castro said, "If those who have in their hands the arms--those who occupy key positions ---are disposed to satisfy the desire of the Cuban people, the future of Cuba can be completely different and better than these last 10 years."

The prime minister's sister addressed in a Spanish-language broadcast beamed to Cuba, "The people of Cuba suffer inhuman tyranny" under the Communist regime.

"With Fidel in power, there will not be peace in Cuba nor in the Americas," she said. "However, the internal situation in Cuba indicates that these things can change."
