SAIGON, Vietnam, July 7 (AP) — President Ngo Dinh Diem of South Vietnam today observed his seventh anniversary in power with a strong attack on neutralism.

"Can one remain neutral faced with this resolute and systematic destruction?" he asked. "One must be relentless in rejecting and combating the bellicose HWA Communist fanaticism, the enemy of the human race, instead of letting oneself become paralyzed by its insidious propaganda."
